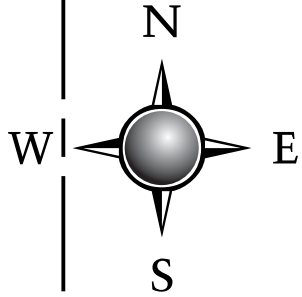
- \$22 Scout and adult cost includes three meals and overnight stay in adjacent dormitory.

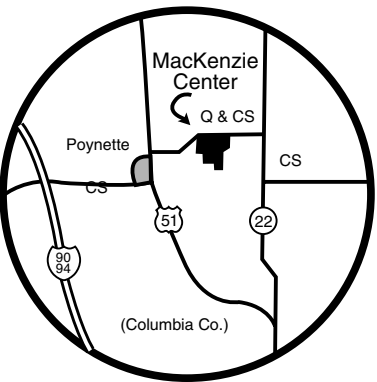
