Monday, February 1 Troop Meeting, Winter Court of Honor

Camp Phillips Kick Off promotion. To register for Camp or Isle Royale Backpacking, Scouts must reserve their spot with Treasurer Mr. Werner and make a \$50 non-refundable deposit from their troop account.

Monday, March 22 Troop Meeting

Deadline for Scouts to register and deposit fee for Camp Phillips and Isle Royale.

Tuesday, March 23

Troop 420 must submit non-refundable \$50 fee per Scout and adult to the Chippewa Valley Council.

Monday, April 26 Troop Meeting

Deadline for Scouts to remit \$220 balance to Troop 420. A \$20 late fee will apply to balances received after this date.

Tuesday, April 27

Troop 420 must submit total balance due to Chippewa Valley Council to avoid late fees.

*Camp Phillips increased cost per Scout by \$10 from 2009. Troop 420 cost includes \$50 toward total \$1,600 bus cost and minimum camp fees assuming fees are paid before deadlines. Scouts who cannot afford camp cost or need a longer payment schedule should contact Treasurer
