

Troop 420 Camper Packing List

Camp Phillips 2016

To present in Dean Medical Center Parking Lot, 752 North High Point Road

- Sack lunch and beverage to eat and drink when we arrive at Camp Phillips
- Medications and instructions (Mr. Hundal will collect)
- Rain gear (put in the top of your bag so you can show your patrol leader)

Scout Gear

- Complete Class A Uniform: shirt, shorts or pants, belt, socks, neckerchief with slide or bolo tie. Like all Troop 420 outings, uniform inspection will occur before boarding the bus and your uniform is worn on the way to and from camp. Camp Phillips rules also require complete Class A uniform for evening supper.
- Order of the Arrow sash, if OA member
- Scout Handbook
- Notebook and pencils for merit badge work
- Merit badge book, if you already own it; or Troop merit badge book if we own it.

Clothing

- Sturdy, comfortable athletic or hiking shoe: Camp rules require shoes at all times except at the swimming beach
- Sandals for swimming beach only
- Swim suit; goggles, if desired
- Six pairs of socks and six pairs of underwear
- Extra shorts and pants
- Extra shirts, Class B Scouting shirts preferred
- Sweatshirt and jacket
- Pajamas
- Handkerchief

Personal Gear

- Suit case with wheels works best or a duffle bag or a backpack
- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Fitted twin sheet to put around mattress
- Personal toiletries: toothpaste and brush, soap, shampoo, comb, etc.
- Towel and wash cloth
- Dirty laundry bag
- Light rope for clothes line to dry wet clothes (clothes cannot be hung in cabins)
- Flashlight and/or headlight with extra batteries
- Pocket knife and Totin' Chip (First time campers will earn Totin' Chip at Camp)
- Wrist watch, required (*What time is it? It's time to bring your watch to Camp!*)
- Water bottle
- Daypack to carry water bottle, swimsuit, merit badge work, etc.
- Spending money for trading post & fast food lunch on trip home
- Troop 420 will supply sunscreen and mosquito repellant and both will be placed in a nylon bag under the campsite shelter

Optional Gear

- Camera (disposable cameras work well)
- Fishing gear; required if Scout is taking the Fishing merit badge
- Postcards or envelopes with stamps to send home to family
- Sunglasses and wide brimmed hat for additional sun protection
- Bible or prayer book

Items Prohibited by Camp Phillips Rules and Regulations

- Firearms: Camp provides rifles, ammunition, and archery equipment at the Shooting Sports area. Under no circumstances can ammunition be brought to Camp
- Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are not permitted; possession of these substances on Camp property will be cause for removal from Camp
- Tobacco Products, Smoking is not allowed anywhere on Camp property
- Fireworks, skateboards, in-line skates, bicycles, & boom boxes are not permitted
- Cell Phones, CD or MP3 Players, Laser pointers, Inappropriate t-shirts, or Excessive Jewelry
- Knives with blades over 3.5 inches

Items Prohibited by Troop 420 Policy on the Bus and at Camp Phillips

- Electronic games and devices (Gameboy, PSP, etc.)
- Music listening devices (CD players, MP3 players, iPods, tape players, etc.)
- Martial arts devices
- Large knives
- Adult only magazines

If a Scout chooses to bring a prohibited item to Camp, when found, the item will be confiscated and the Scout's parent(s) will be immediately contacted to retrieve their son from Camp. If in doubt, contact Scoutmaster Sarbpal Hundal before you bring it.

Scouts should leave cell phones at home. If there is a need for a Scout to call home, one of our adults can help make arrangements for a call.
